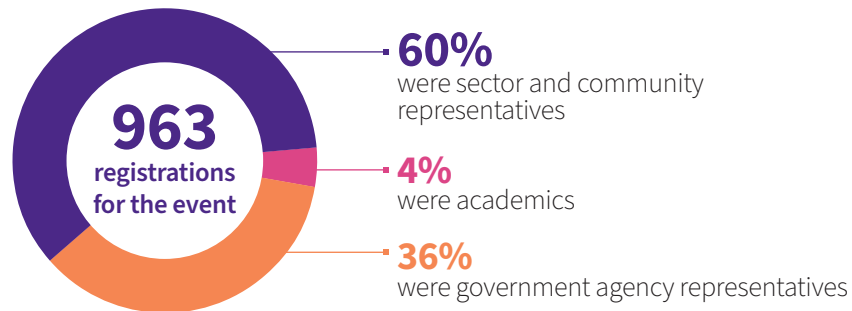


Te Aorerekura Annual Hui 2022

Te Puna Aonui – the Joint Venture for the Elimination of Family Violence and Sexual Violence hosted the inaugural virtual Hui on 27-28 July 2022.

The two days were split into the six Shifts within Te Aorerekura, including discussion panels, as well as a focus on learning and monitoring.

Important themes emerged in the 2022 Hui

Across the Hui sessions, the common themes can be summarised as:



Te Aorerekura sets a pathway

Participants were asked to indicate whether they agree that:

“Te Aorerekura sets a pathway for how tangata whenua, communities, the specialist sectors, and government can work together to eliminate family violence and sexual violence over a generation”.

Out of a score of 5 (1 being strongly disagree, 5 being strongly agree), the average score was 3.77.
